Meadfurlong School will do its best to:

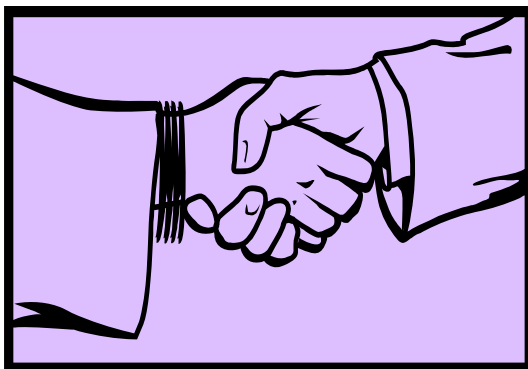
- Care for the safety and well-being of all the children.
