I hope you all have a very pleasant Easter Holiday and are able to enjoy some better weather.

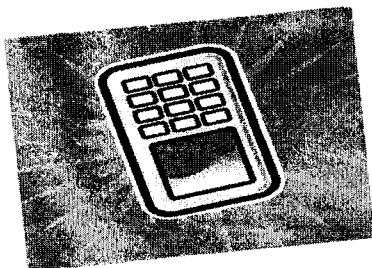


### Parentmail
